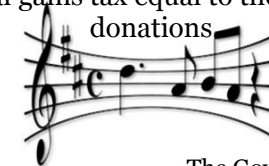

**Tax claimed by CRC**

- CRC will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give on or after 6 April 2008.

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
